Shirley Anne Brown Jensen, daughter of Thirza Berrett and Wallace Alma Brown, was born February 9, 1930, in Murray, Utah and passed away July 17, 2009 at Sandy Regional Care Center. Shirley attended Holladay Elementary and Olympus Junior High Schools. A member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, she served faithfully for many years as president of the choir in the Olympus 3rd Ward and wrote letters to missionaries.

On September 3, 1954, Shirley married Robert Hart Jensen, Jr. in the Salt Lake LDS Temple. They were well suited to each other and cared for each other until Bob's death on December 14, 2002.

Shirley lived with some limited capacities, but her capacity to love her family and friends was in no way limited. She treasured her experiences with her grandmother who taught her embroidery, a skill which enabled Shirley to create lovely gifts for friends and family.
